* Please note that all bookings are subject to the Town Hall Theatre €1 per ticket Booking & Facility Development fee (max €5 per transaction). This fee will enable us to continually invest in facilities and equipment at the Town Hall and Black Box Theatres.

Concessions/Group Rates

We offer discounts on most shows - concessions apply to under 18-year-olds, students, senior citizens and the unwaged. Proof of eligibility and ID required. 10% discount for groups of 10+. Some exceptions apply.

Accessibility & Special Assistance

Please let us know - when booking your tickets - of any special requirements so we can make your visit as enjoyable as possible. If you book online, you should phone or email us to let us know of any special requirements. The Town Hall Theatre main auditorium and the Black Box Theatre auditorium are fully accessible to wheelchair users. The Town Hall Studio is not accessible for wheelchair users. There is a Loop System in place in the main auditorium of the Town Hall Theatre. There are two accessible parking spaces on Waterside immediately by the venue and a further two spaces on nearby Corrib Terrace.

Latecomers & Admission

Late Admission cannot be guaranteed and can only occur if there is a suitable break in the performance. Please aim to arrive 20 mins before advertised time and please allow adequate time for traffic and parking. Please double check your tickets to ensure you have the correct date and time for your performance.

Refunds & Exchanges

We regret that tickets cannot be exchanged or refunded unless a performance is cancelled or abandoned - your statutory rights are not affected.

Mobile Phones & Electronic Devices

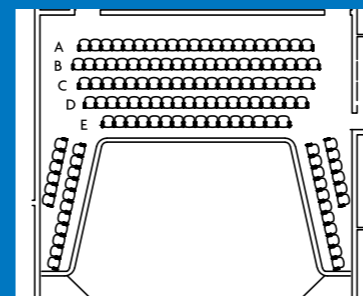

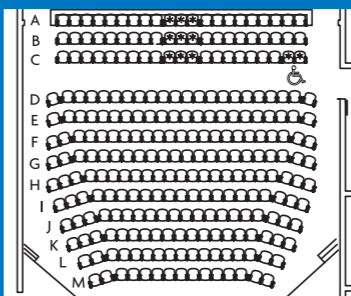

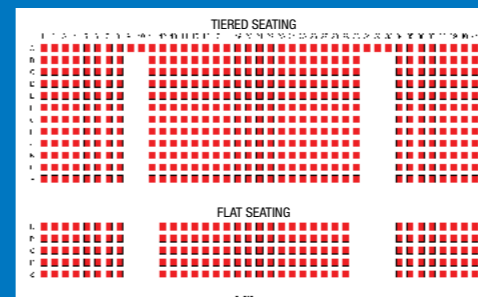

This January we celebrate 150 years since the birth of Maurice Ravel, one of the most original and sophisticated composers of the twentieth century.
